APRIL (2174) GRADUATION DEADLINES AND REQUIREMENTS

You are responsible for reading the following information regarding graduation. Not following the requirements listed below could jeopardize your graduation.

I. <u>Application for Graduation</u>: Any student who plans to complete a degree or certification program in the Fall Term must submit an application for graduation to Shelly Kinsel (5500 Posvar Hall) by <u>Friday</u>, <u>January 13</u>, <u>2017</u>. With your application, you must also submit an <u>approved Plan of Studies</u>.

*Students who applied for graduation in a prior term, but *did* <u>not</u> graduate <u>must reapply</u> for the current term.

Only the student's legal name may be used on the application.

- **II.** Registration Requirements: Students must be registered for a minimum of one credit in the term in which they plan to graduate.
- III. Incomplete Grades: All I and G grades in required courses must be changed by the end of the term in order to qualify for graduation. Students are responsible for contacting their instructor to ask that a change of grade form be submitted to 5500 Posvar Hall.
- IV. Complete the following requirements:
 - a. Must have full status (not provisional)
 - b. Pass Comprehensive Examination (or equivalent requirement)
- V. Candidates for the Master of Arts and Master of Science Degrees must also:
 - a. Complete an IRB form (if required; consult advisor)
 - b. Be Admitted to Candidacy
 - c. Pass oral defense or thesis (as required in individual programs)
- VI. <u>Candidates Completing a Master's Thesis:</u>

- VII. <u>Diplomas and Official Transcripts:</u> Diplomas and a complimentary copy of your official transcript indicating your degree are expected to be mailed the week of June 26, 2017 to the address on your application for graduation.
