TITLE OF POLICY: ACADEMIC PROBATION & DISMISSAL

ACADEMIC PROBATION:

A full status student shall be placed on academic probation if she or he has failed to meet the following GPA and credit requirements:

| Degree Level | GPA | Credits |
|--------------------|-----|--------------------|
| Bachelor's student | 2.5 | 75 credits or more |
| Master's student | 3.0 | 6 credits or more |
| Doctoral student | 3.3 | 9 credits or more |

Only letter grades with GPA values will be used to compute and determine academic probation status. While on probation students are limited to registering only for courses in which a letter grade is given.

To be removed from probation status, a student must achieve the following GPA requirements for the equivalent of one full-time term.

| Degree Level | GPA | Credits |
|--------------------|-----|-------------------|
| Bachelor's student | 3.0 | 9 credits or more |
| Master's student | 3.5 | 6 credits or more |
| Doctoral student | 3.5 | 6 credits or more |

A student can only be placed academic probation status once during their program of study.

Students placed on academic probation status will be sent a letter from the School of Education, recommending that they seek guidance from their academic advisor.

ACADEMIC DISSMISAL:

A student that does not meet the following GPA or credit requirements will be dismissed from the School of Education, unless serious extenuating circumstances exist. The request for continuation must include a recommendation made by the Department Chair (or designated faculty member) and the academic advisor, with the recommendation approved by the Dean of the school.
